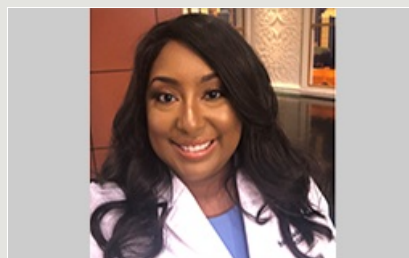

IMMIGRANTS' RIGHTS

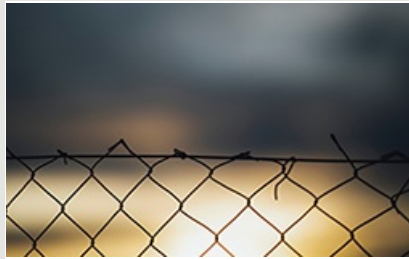
